

# BAREFOOT BOWLS PRIVATE BOOKINGS



## AN ACTIVITY FOR ALL

The Croydon Bowling club can host Barefoot Bowls events from 10 up to 150 people. There are 2 bowling greens (one under lights), a fully stocked bar and catering available.

Barefoot Bowls is an activity that everyone can participate in.

We recommend that you allow 6 people per rink when considering your booking and also allow that not everyone will want to bowl for the entire 90-minute session.



### Things you should know:

- Each Session is strictly 90mins in duration.
- Bookings are confirmed once deposit has been paid.
- Only pay for Rinks (bowling lanes) a maximum of 8 people per lane.
- Full refund of deposit, if cancelled more than 48hrs prior to booking.
- Hall Hire and Catering also available.
- If weather impacted bookings can be rescheduled or deposit refunded.
- Each lane costs \$120 per 90 minute session

# BAREFOOT BOWLS FAQ'S



## Frequently Asked Questions

Q) How many people can play on each rink at one time?

A) The maximum number of players on a rink is 4 vs 4, a total of 8 .

Q) How many players do you recommend?

A) Whilst 8 is the maximum we suggest 3 vs 3 is a good balance of being cost effective but not having to wait too long between turns.

Q) Do we pay per bowler?

A) No, at Croydon Bowling Club you pay per rink. A rink is similar to a lane in ten pin bowling. The cost is \$120 per rink for 90 minutes.

Q) How many people per booking?

A) Most people don't want to bowl for the full 90mins, preferring to swap in and out with friends. We can accommodate up to 100 people in a booking.

Q) What if the weather doesn't permit the booking to go ahead?

A) We are happy to refund or rebook if the weather doesn't permit.

Q) What is the cancelation policy?

A) There is a 48 hour cancelation policy. A full refund will be issued if 48 hours' notice is provided, otherwise the deposit will be forfeited.

Q) Can we bring our own food or drink to the club?

A) The club has a strict **no** BYO policy for all drinks, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic. Self-catering can be booked.

Q) What is the appropriate footwear?

A) Comfortable, flat soled shoes. Runners are a good example.

Q) How old must children be to play?

A) We ask that children are supervised at all times. We suggest no younger than 8 years old.

Q) Is there someone there to explain and assist?

A) Yes, all bookings include volunteer members be present to assist
